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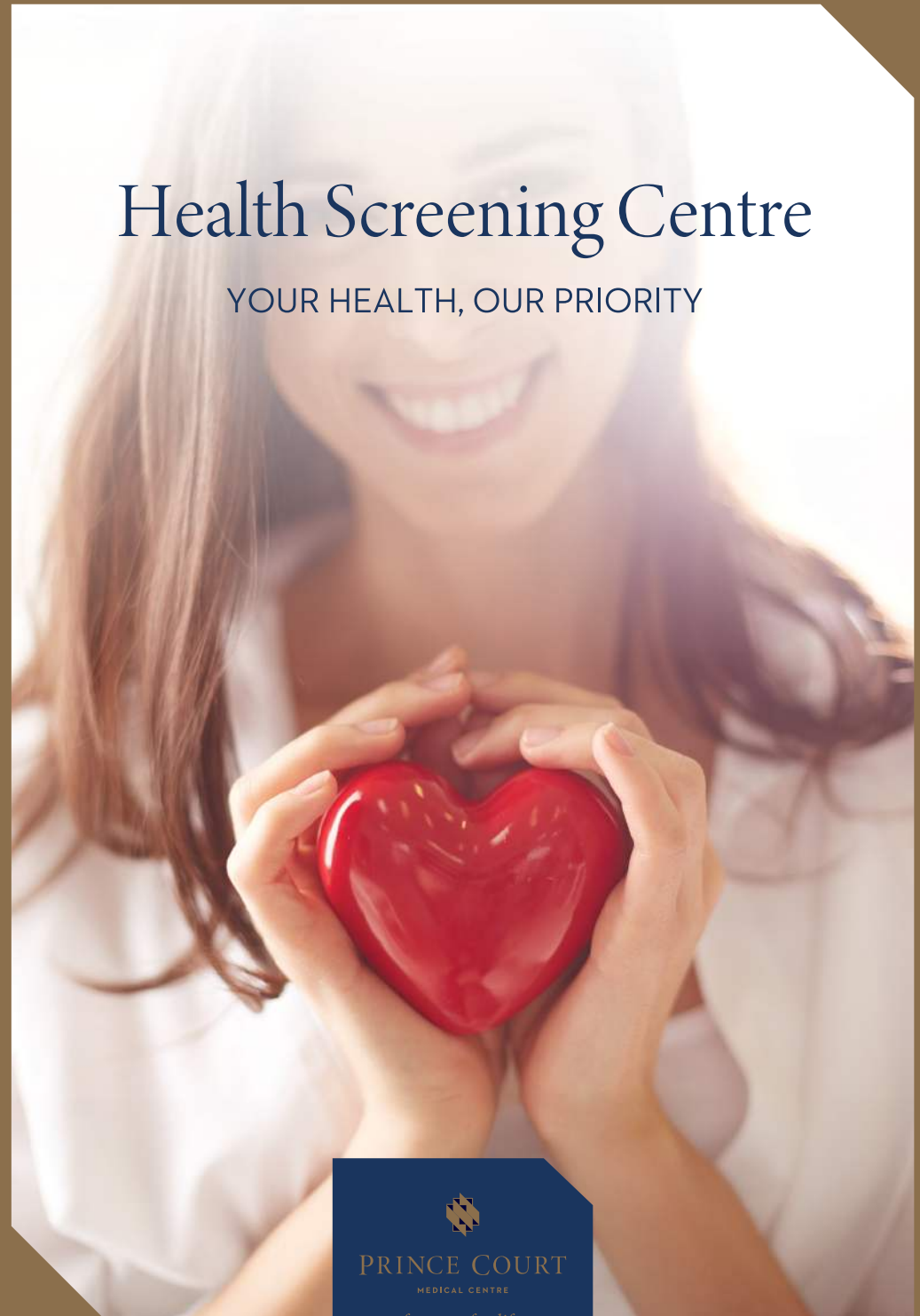

## PREPARATION

- Fasting: Kindly fast for 8 hours before the tests. You may drink plain water during this fasting period.
- Medications: If you have high blood pressure, you may continue taking your routine morning medicine until your blood sample is taken.
- Stress Test: If you are scheduled for a Stress Test, remember to bring along an additional change of clothes and suitable footwear for the test.
- Pap-smear: For Pap-smear, it is best to schedule the test 3 days after the last day of your menstruation.
- Time Allocation: Please allocate 3 - 4 hours for the completion of all procedures.
